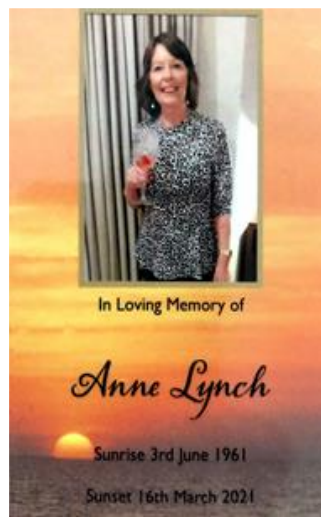
Fun Bingo Night
