A week-long transformation project is headed to the Balgaddy community in July 2022. The goal is to re-envision the grassy community area next to the Balgaddy playground and sport courts in a 2-day, community-led placemaking event that will help residents, small business, and nonprofits get creative with their public neighborhood space. The event will have food trucks, a DJ, karaoke machine, Irish programming, a games truck and more to celebrate the new space.
