# Extract from Homily of Archbishop Dermot Feast of St. Kevin, June 3rd

To celebrate St Kevin is to remember that while we are gathered in this place at this time, we belong to a community of faith that extends across time and space. Kevin's quest to encounter the Lord is still our quest. Kevin's mission to form disciples is echoed in our own day.

Reflecting on Kevin of Glendalough, we see once again how the invitation to know and follow Jesus is the work of the Spirit: we are called to open ourselves to the Spirit, so that our lives and our ministry may express that invitation to encounter the Lord. It is appropriate, then – indeed it is necessary – that we pray that the Spirit enlighten our minds and renew our hearts. The Novena to the Holy Spirit is a profound recognition that we can only respond to what the Lord asks of his Church in Dublin through earnest prayer and conversion of heart, such as we see in the life of Kevin and Laurence, our patrons.
