Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls

1. From 12 Noon on 1st November until midnight on 2nd November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the pope's intentions, can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostles Creed.

The indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1st November. Holy Communion may be received any day from 1st to 8th November.

2. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th November. The conditions mentioned above also apply for this.
