The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is traditionally observed 18th - 25th January – the Octave of St Peter and St Paul. Its inauguration in Dublin will take place at an Interdenominational Service on Sunday 18th January 2026, 8pm, at St Thomas Indian Orthodox Church in Palmerstown, Dublin 20, D20 VP97. Bishop Hovakim Manukyan, Primate of the Armenian Church of the UK and Ireland, will be the speaker at this Ecumenical Service.

The prayers and reflections for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity this year have been prepared by the Armenian Apostolic Church together with the Armenian Catholic and Evangelical Churches. The theme chosen, "One Body, One Spirit", is inspired by St Paul's Letter to the Ephesians: "There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling."
